Do It By Law - Florida Lemon Law Checklist

Use this checklist to determine if your vehicle qualifies under Florida's Lemon Law

[]	The vehicle was purchased or leased NEW in Florida.
[]	The vehicle is still within the first 24 months of the original delivery date.
[]	The vehicle has a substantial defect affecting its use, value, or safety.
[]	The defect occurred while the vehicle was under the manufacturer's warranty.
[]	You have given the manufacturer at least 3 attempts to repair the defect.
[]	The vehicle has been out of service for 15 or more cumulative days for repairs.
[]	The manufacturer was notified of the problem in writing (if required).
[]	You have retained all repair records, receipts, and communications.
[]	The issue remains unresolved after reasonable repair attempts.
[]	You are ready to file a Lemon Law claim or request arbitration.
