

Do It By Law - Florida Lemon Law Checklist

Use this checklist to determine if your vehicle qualifies under Florida's Lemon Law

- ☐ The vehicle was purchased or leased NEW in Florida.
- ☐ The vehicle is still within the first 24 months of the original delivery date.
- ☐ The vehicle has a substantial defect affecting its use, value, or safety.
- ☐ The defect occurred while the vehicle was under the manufacturer's warranty.
- ☐ You have given the manufacturer at least 3 attempts to repair the defect.
- ☐ The vehicle has been out of service for 15 or more cumulative days for repairs.
- ☐ The manufacturer was notified of the problem in writing (if required).
- ☐ You have retained all repair records, receipts, and communications.
- ☐ The issue remains unresolved after reasonable repair attempts.
- ☐ You are ready to file a Lemon Law claim or request arbitration.
